INVESTMENT COMMENTARY

SKAGEN m² lagged its benchmark index slightly in July but is still ahead year to date. July was a busy month for central banks, and we witnessed the Federal Reserve raise its key rate to a 22-year high on the back of a still tight labour market and slightly higher than expected CPI figures, while keeping their options open for more to come later this year. The ECB also hiked their rates to a historic high, however hinted at a potential pause at the next meeting. Most surprising for the market was the Bank of Japan, which changed its cap on ten-year government-bond yields from 0.5% to 1%, taking a small step away from its long-established ultra conservative policy.

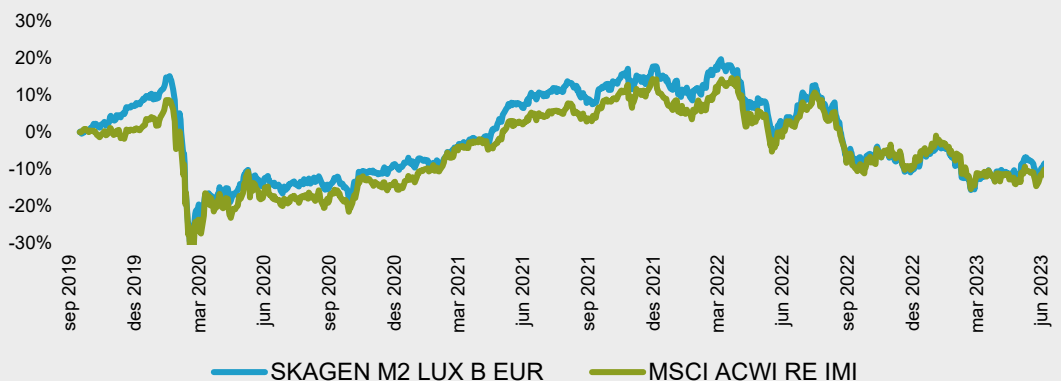
The fund's top performers in July were Swedish office and logistics player Castellum, UK Residential company Grainger and Norwegian Self-Storage Group. Castellum posted a second quarter report with no major surprises, smaller value declines than previous quarters and a stronger balance sheet following its equity raise, which reduces some of the downside risks.

The fund's worst performers in the month were US residential company Independence Realty Trust (IRT), Brazilian logistics company LOG and US tower company American Tower. IRT delivered a second quarter report with mixed results. The news of increasing occupancy and improving FFO guidance due to lower costs was well received. However, lower reported ROI on its value-add pipeline and slightly lower blended rate growth than its peers for the quarter came in as a negative. We believe IRT is well positioned with its class B product to withstand a tougher US economic environment and will be more insulated from the increasing supply of class A products entering the sunbelt states.

SKAGEN m² continues to focus on resilient companies in trend driven subsegments that are mispriced, can perform in various market conditions, have solid balance sheets, and are well positioned for inflation.

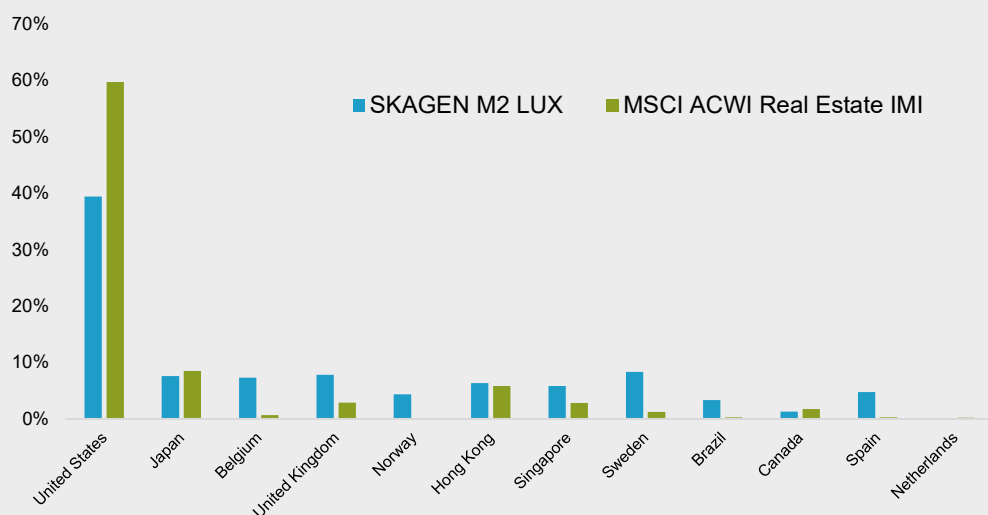
